1. After examining all our tra ^{Por ALRB Jean FBI} e are convinced beyond reasonable doubt that he is a ^{ice} member of the KGB. Contributing to this conclusion are his associates, his movements, his Mexican and other contacts and his cover position, as well as his involvement in the ~~TUMBLEWEED~~ operation.

2. KOSTIKOV's involvement in ~~TUMBLEWEED~~ is our only reason to believe that he is connected with the 13th Department. KOSTIKOV was in clandestine contact with ~~TUMBLEWEED~~ (as definitely confirmed by ~~TUMBLEWEED~~'s photo identification) and arranged ~~TUMBLEWEED~~'s contact in the U.S. with a KGB colleague of KOSTIKOV's. This colleague was identified by ~~TUMBLEWEED~~ from photos as Oleg BRYKIN, who has definitely been identified by a reliable FBI source as a member of the 13th Department.
