T-2 has recounted that he first met Dr. TULCHIN during September, 1947, at a DP Camp in Bremen, Germany. The Informant stated that he lived in the same room with TULCHIN for about one month. According to the Informant, there were five occupants in this room. Concerning the other three individuals who lived in the previously mentioned room, the Informant gave the following information:

The Informant stated that VOSHININ was a civil engineer. He was presently employed as a contractor by a steel company in New York City. He said that he had known VOSHININ in Belgrade, Yugoslavia, and that VOSHININ had been married in Painchevo, Yugoslavia. He recalled that VOSHININ had been in close contact with Dr. TULCHIN; however, VOSHININ was believed to be anti-Communist and reliable. T-2 expressed the belief that VOSHININ would be able to furnish the address of another of Dr. TULCHIN's roommates— one HODORORSKY.

T-2 declared that HODORORSKY was a graduate of the White Russian Cadet Corps, Bela Crkva, Yugoslavia, some fifteen years ago. He explained that the full name of this cadet corps was "The Russian Cadet Corps of the Great Constantine Constanovich." The Informant recalled that HODORORSKY had attended the University of Zagreb. He expressed the opinion that HODORORSKY was anti-Communist and reliable.
