All persons interviewed were advised that the U. S. Government does not want any military expedition against Cuba to leave from the U. S. Persons interviewed advised that they would abide by U. S. Government policy in this matter.

CARLOS ZARRAGA MARTINEZ advised that CIA had contacted this group of 6 individuals and told them not to go on any military mission against Cuba.

LOMBERTO DIAZ RODRIGUEZ advised he worked for CIA and that his boat "Cacique" has been on missions to Cuba CIA. (S)(A)(U)
