GEORGE FRANCIS, MENTIONED IN RE TELETYPE IS UNDER DEVELOPMENT AS A PCI BY MIAMI. FRANCIS, ONE OF OWNERS OF THE NACIONAL CASINO, HAVANA, UNDER BATISTA REGIME, NOW IN US AS VISITOR, AND IS A WHITE NATIONAL OF HAITI. FRANCIS ADVISED THIS DATE APPROXIMATELY THREE WEEKS AGO A MIAMI CUBAN EXILE, GREGORIO SILVA, ASKED FRANCIS TO JOIN HIM AT A MEETING AT THE MIAMI COLONIAL HOTEL, MIAMI, TO LISTEN TO AN AMERICAN CITIZEN WHO WAS BEING INTRODUCED TO MIAMI CUBANS BY ONE (FNU) SIERRA. SILVA AND FRANCIS ATTENDED MEETING WHICH LASTED APPROXIMATELY ONE HOUR. THE AMERICAN, WHOSE NAME FRANCIS CANNOT RECALL, SPOKE FOR ONE HALF HOUR TO GROUP WHICH CONSISTED OF APPROXIMATELY 40 CUBANS. HE WAS INTRODUCED TO GROUP BY SIERRA WHO STATED THE AMERICAN WAS REPRESENTING A GROUP OF VERY LARGE AMERICAN COMPANIES WHICH WERE WILLING TO SPEND MILLIONS OF DOLLARS TO OVERTHROW CASTRO IN CUBA, IF THEY WERE ASSURED THAT THE REFUGEE CUBANS IN THE US HAVE ACHIEVED UNITY ON THIS SUBJECT. HE DID NOT IDENTIFY ANY OF THESE COMPANIES. SOMEONE IN THE GROUP QUESTIONED HOW THE STATE DEPARTMENT WOULD LOOK UPON SUCH A PROJECT, AND THE AMERICAN SAID THEY WOULD BE WILLING TO COOPERATE IF UNITY OF THE REFUGEES WERE ASSURED. THE AMERICAN FURTHER MENTIONED THAT HE HAD TALKED WITH CERTAIN US SENATORS WHO WERE INTERESTED IN THE PROJECT AND INDICATED SYMPATHY WITH IT.

PCI ADVISED BOTH SIERRA AND THE AMERICAN INDICATED THEY
