## Current Situation

Current Station defection targets include the Cuban Ambassador nimbel!, who has many times been reported to be susceptible, and Odon ALVAREZ de la Campa, an important official of the CICR in Cuba, who reportedly has sent out cossages that he wishes to defect. The Station is now trying to get more information in the latter case.
