SUBJECT: Notification of Cryptographic Clearance - Hunt, E. Howard, Jr.


1. Subject employee has been granted a cryptographic clearance under the provisions of CIA Regulation 90-500. Clearance is effective 20 February 1957.

2. Subject has been informed of the granting of clearance, has been briefed concerning cryptographic and related communications security matters, and has signed a Briefing Statement acknowledging responsibility for the protection of cryptographic information.

3. When Subject employee no longer requires the clearance in order to perform his assigned duties, it is requested that the Communications Security Division (2411 I Bldg., Ext. 3021) be notified by WH, so that the clearance may be revoked.
