Memorandum for the Record: Safehouse for ANNUG-1

1. Per verbal agreement with Mr. ^{11/03} [redacted] this date, it was decided to use the following safehouse presently available for immediate use.

2. This apartment was viewed by C/WH/SA/CI yesterday and considered adequate for ANNUG-1. Undersigned and Mr. ⁰³ [redacted] will inventory household equipment on 19 May 1964 (tentatively) and move A-1 into the abovementioned quarters a day or two thereafter, depending upon when W-D Staffers are finished debriefing A-1. Mr. ⁰³ [redacted] advised that he will inform Mr. ⁰³ [redacted] Safehouse Branch, X3683, that it will no longer be necessary for the Branch to inquire re prospective apartments for A-1 in the N.W. section of Washington, per WH/SA 64-376 dated 6 May 1964.
