SUBJECT: General: Debriefing Report # 46 of ARKUG-1
Specific: Soviet Troops in Cuba

1. The Source does not know about the units to which the Soviet troops are assigned.
2. The significance of the colors worn by the troops apparently belonging to the same unit is unknown to the Source.
3. Most of the Soviet troops are 25 years old and younger. Most of the troops are small and thin.
