Reference is made to the CIRA-0371-74 dated 27 June 1974 attached.

The matter was referred to the undersigned because of possible "Watergate" implications. I reviewed all the files; the files of the staff employees concerned reveal no "Watergate" connection whatsoever. St. George, a writer, has of course made recent allegations to the effect that the agency had prior knowledge of Watergate - these charges are without foundation and the agency has responded to them apparently to the satisfaction of the various government activities concerned. The files of the former staffers are being declassified however because of St. George's previous charges vis a vis the agency. This was discussed with and approved by the DDS/PSI on 15 July 1974.
