The AMOTs were requested to furnish any derogatory traces in their files on the Cubans listed in referenced report as travelling to and from El Salvador during the period 8 September to 5 October 1964. The only such trace turned up is one on a Silvia DURAN, possibly identical with the Silvia Ondina DUPAN y Parades who left El Salvador for Costa Rica on 8 September 1964. According to AMOT information dated 18 August 1963, reported by AMOT-152, Silvia DURAN was appointed Secretary to Eusebio AZCUE, Cuban Consul in charge of the Consular Section of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City.

1. SYLVIA TIRADO DE DURAN AXA SYLVIA DE TIRADO, MEXICAN CITIZEN, WAS EMPLOYED BY CUBAN CONSULATE OFFICE MEXI AS TEMPORARY REPLACEMENT MARICARMEN OLIPARRI UPON LATTER'S DEATH JULY 63. DURAN WAS DIRECTOR MEXICAN-CUBAN INSTITUTE CULTURAL RELATIONS (IMCRC) UNTIL EARLY JAN 63 WHEN PRESSED BY TERESA FROENZA TO RESIGN. (SEE MEXI 3035, 9 JAN 63)

2. BEFORE JULY 63, PER LIENVOY, DURAN HAD SPORADIC CONTACT CUBAN EMBASSY, MAINLY WITH FROENZA RE IMCRC MATTERS. FALL 62 HAD AFFAIR WITH CARLOS LECHUGA. (SEE MEXI 2719, 26 NOV 62 AND HMMA 20648, 4 FEB 63). IN JUNE 62 LICOOKY-1 REPORTED THAT JOSE REVUELTAS SAID DURAN STRONGLY DRAWN TO HIS LIGA LENINISTA ESPARTACO, LOCAL DISSIDENT COMMUNIST GROUP.

3. SEE ALSO HMMA-12284, 8 DEC 61 (LAURICLE) WHICH STATION CANNOT CONFIRM, AND HMMA-3126, 28 SEP 62 WHICH STATION CANNOT EVALUATE.

4. RE PARA TWO REF: STATION QUERIED (LITAMIL NINE) THIS POINT NIGHT 23 NOV AND HE DISCLAIMED ANY KNOWLEDGE OSWALD VISITS. HE HAS BEEN INSTRUCTED REPORT ANY NEW FACTS OR SIGNIFICANT REACTION HIS ASSOCIATES.
