Dear Dr. Mocco:

The above captioned individual was unable to complete his training at the Miami Barber College seven months ago and has continued to take treatment from a psychiatrist, but does not appear to have recovered to the point that he wishes or is medically able to enter training leading to employment.

We have kept this case open for a number of months hoping that the doctor would release him and that he would be in a position to consider training. Since there appears to be no further purpose in retaining this case open as he is not able to return to training, we are closing this case from our vocational rehabilitation program without bias and if in the future, he should reach the point where he is able to take training and become employable, we would be willing to consider him as a client of our regular program.
