- On 9 September Dr. Rene Rayneri Parla, Cuban Ambassador to El Salvador, and a delegation of Salvadoran students, led by Dr. Carlos VEGA, left San Salvador for Habana aboard a Cuban Airlines plane.
- Salvadoran Government officials confiscated propaganda from the plane on its arrival in San Salvador on 8 September, including a 98-page booklet by General Alberto BAYO, entitled Ciento Cincuenta Preguntas a un Guerrillero, third edition.
- Luis PORTUONDO, Cuban student representative, came on the plane to accompany the student delegation back to Cuba.
- On board the plane were: Captain Napoleon DIEGO, Captain Hugo Burr,² Lt. Jose DIAZ Vasquez, Lt. Erasmo Chang, Lt. Alberto BAYO,³ and Corporal Domingo MARTINEZ, crew members; Adela PONCE Penorio, Aura Josefina BURGOS, Leticia FLORES Henriquez, Maria Trinidad JOVEL, Maria Izabel DIAZ, Marta Guadalupe FLORES, Maria Josefina GUIROLA, Silvia Margarita CASTELLANOS, Lillian ROMERO Villagran, Armida PARADA Fortin, Flavia A.
