SUBJECT: **COMMANDOS L**
IS - CUBA
INTERNAL SECURITY-CUBA

The captioned organization, consisting of anti-Castro Cuban refugees, periodically has come to our attention in connection with raids planned or directed against Cuba. [Desmond Fitzgerald, CIA, furnished the following to the Liaison Agent on 10/7/63.]

Pursuant to instructions from the White House, CIA is currently exploring the possibilities of collaborating with this organization in promoting activities directed against the Castro Government. This will include raids against Cuba. All such raids would be initiated from British territory in the Bahamas and it will be necessary for [redacted]

Fitzgerald requested that this information not be disseminated outside of the Bureau and he further asked that if the Bureau received any information concerning Commandos L activities, such data not be disseminated to the British without first consulting with CIA.

ACTION:

The Nationalities Intelligence Section has been informed concerning the above. If approved, we will not disseminate information to the British without first consulting with CIA.
