Bosch was one of many critical of CIA policy & personnel following Bay of Pigs. However, in March 1962, WAVE requested a POA on Bosch, advising he was "cooperative and secure." To be utilized as General Coordinator of Eulio Dague group. POA granted on 6 March 1962. Given polygraph in May 1962 & came out clean. His clearance was cancelled in Nov. 1962.

Bosch aligns himself with individuals and organizations that are currently involved in operations against Cuba, usually serving as General Coordinator & takes responsibility for securing financial backing.
