SUBJECT: Contact Report - Antonio VACLAVA Blazens

1. (C) Two members of UNACOD (using assumed names) met with Antonio VACLAVA on 21 January. The purpose of the meeting was primarily to discuss the activities of the organization, which had been contacted by the Cuban government. VACLAVA was advised that the Cuban government was interested in the activities of the organization and was willing to provide assistance in the form of training and equipment.
