I know that I put something together for these documents before I returned them to CIA last month, but I cannot find it. I submit to you now a very generalized reconstruction of the summary of those records. If this is inadequate please let me know and I will try to get more information to you. Thanks. In March, the Review Board acted on 1245 CIA records, the highest total to date. The vast majority of these records are from the first 15 reels of the microfilm which is contained in box 64 of CIA's Sequestered Collection. The subjects of these 201 files, files that had been made available to the HSCA, cover the spectrum of individuals the HSCA considered to be of relevance, or of possible relevance, to the assassination, individuals from diverse contexts such as the Oswald story or the anti-Castro Cuban exile activities.
