Subject: Update on White

Jeremy:I exchanged voice mail messages this afternoon with White's attorney, Bob Adler. He told me in response to my call:1. He wants to change my meeting with White and him from Wednesday to Thursday at 1:00 p.m. (I said that was okay and confirmed for Thursday.)2. White does not have an inventory.Before that meeting, I would like to get your views on the interview. Specifically, these are the points I'd like to get your views on:1. General tone - How do we want to approach him in this interview? How much do I press him when he gives an answer that I'd like more info on? Do we convey that it is in his interest to cooperate fully now? Or is what we really want a road map for now, with a likely later interview the hard one in which he is really pressed?2. Nature of the questions - What should we be asking him at this stage? How specific? For example, the dictabelts?3. How much information do we give him? - We've heard several hints or second/third hand reports on what he has that is related to our work. How far do we go with this information in the questioning? How much do we reveal at this stage?My views:1. I would like to start out by asking him in general what he has; not artifacts, but records. Then, hone the discussion to a focus on assassination records.2. I'd like to "run a laundry list" with him of all of the primary players (JFK, Oswald, Ruby, Connally, etc.) and the events related to the assassination (the assassination itself, the aftermath, planning of the trip, Ruby shooting of Oswald, aftermath) and ask him if he has records related to them.Any thoughts you have would be helpful. Maybe we can talk tomorrow, either early or later in the day.Thanks.Tom
