**Subject:** JFK Library Update on Miscellaneous Matters

I spoke with Megan Desnoyers late today and have the following matters to report:1. Burke Marshall has agreed to open the closed parts of his oral history that had been identified as relevant to the assassination.2. The Library has not heard anything from Arthur Schlesinger regarding our letter on his materials that we want opened up.3. Megan has not heard anything from Richard Wade on the 7 ARs that we are seeking to open. (John Nolan and Dave Hackett, the other members have said okay.) She will pursue Wade, try to get his okay then move on to the 137 EHUs.4. Megan will write to Kilduff, McHugh, Rowley, and Yarborough regarding their undeeded oral histories. She said that they have recently been successful in getting deeds from other donors that allow for the histories to be opened in full. (She previously wrote to Smathers and we are holding off on Sheridan for now because of the pending litigation.)In addition, I left a message for Mary Kennifick and asked her to call me back regarding the fact that she only sent us 11 DOD documents, instead of 12 for us to move through declassification.
