Subject: Marie Fehmer Chiarodo/LBJ Library

I today spoke with Marie Fehmer Chiarodo, who was Vice-President Johnson's Secretary and who had kept a notebook regarding events in Dallas on the day of the assassination. I asked whether she might have kept the notebook. Ms. Chiarodo explained that she does not have the notebook and that she has discussed the issue of its whereabouts many times with others, including personnel at the LBJ Library. Ms. Chiarodo explained that this was a standard steno, spiral-bound notebook. After returning from Dallas and consulting with Juanita Roberts, Ms. Chiarodo (then Ms. Fehmer), transcribed some of her notes and sent the notebook to Dorothy Territo in the Old Executibve Office Building (Ms. Territo was in charge of Presidential Archives). The notebook has never been located. According to Ms. Chiarodo, she has discussed this matter with Ms. Territo, who does not recall ever receiving the notebook.
