Subject: Weekly Update

1. Following Board meeting, notified NSA of Board decisions and arranged to review those with NSA officials on November 22.2. Joe and Chris spent two days at the Pentagon reviewing Joint Staff records (several cartons) relating to Cuba. Most of these records focus on operational matters during the time of the Cuban Missile Crisis in 1962 and appear unrelated to the assassination; however, approximately 150 documents relating to MONGOOSE and other anti-Castro activities were identified as possibly assassination-related and will be reviewed in further detail.3. Sent Edward Coyle a copy of the interview transcript for him to review and correct if necessary. Mr. Coyle was also provided an affidavit for signature/notarization attesting to the truthfulness of his interview statements. He should return a corrected copy of the transcript and affidavit to us for transfer to NARA.4. Sent Dr. David Vanek a research copy of the video "The Men Who Killed Kennedy (Part 6)." That video includes segments where Daniel Marvin alleges Vanek was an eyewitness to certain activities Marvin contends are assassination-related. During earlier telephone interview, Vanek said he had no recollection of Marvin or the activities he describes, and in fact was not at Fort Bragg during the time when Marvin alleges one event took place. Perhaps reviewing the video and seeing/hearing Marvin's allegations "firsthand" will prompt Vanek's memory.5. Military team is in the process of preparing draft compliance letters for NSA, Joint Staff, OSD/WHS, Army, Navy/Marines, Air Force, DIA, DOD General Counsel, AFIP, Bethesda Naval Hospital, Arlington Cemetery, CID and IRR.
