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Subject: FYI: Weekly Update-- Military Team
1. Wray and Zimmerman met with FOIA representative of Department of the Army Inspector General's Office on March 6 to present for review approximately 1200 pages from the IRR file of Richard Case Nagell. We emphasized the desirability of a quick turnaround on a small subset of these records, preferably prior to Board meeting on March 13-4.2. Wray met with OSD compliance official David Bosworth on March 6 to discuss current progress on review/consent release of records related to correspondence between DOD General Counsel's office and HSCA. Bosworth has referred these records to Stewart Aly to review and authorize release. (Interesting footnote: these documents include various memos written by then-General Counsel staffer Judith Miller, advising senior DOD officials on compliance matters. Today Ms. Miller is the DOD General Counsel. . .)3. Wray met with Army records managers Ed Arnold and Paul Smith on March 6 regarding propective actions to review/declassify the Califano records at NARA. (Wray had intended to meet newly-designated Army compliance official Linda Dean, but she was unavailable at the time of scheduled appointment.)4. On March 7, Barger and Masih reviewed various FOIA requests on file at IRR, and received first batch of photocopied documents from IRR's "HSCA" files. Various documents within these files had previously been referred to interested agencies in August-September 1995 timeframe; however, in many cases IRR has received no response to these referrals. Our acquisition of these copies will facilitate our intervention to compel required reviews are completed in the near term so that these records can be processed for release and transfer to NARA.5. Wray and Barger met with Steve Tilley on March 10 to discuss procedures for conducting a largescale review/declassification session of Army (Califano files) and Joint Staff records related to Cuba. Tilley has arranged with NARA officials to have the original copies of these records transferred to ARRB offices; this will facilitate indexing, copying and processing for eventual mass-declass session. These records should be transferred to us for storage in our SCIF by week of March 17.6. NSA (Claudia Collins) sent us a letter advising that NSA has no objection to release of FBI record 124-10256-10176 (recently referred to NSA).7. In telephone conversation with Mr. Stephan Weiss (former lieutenant in 112th INTC Group Dallas office at time of the assassination, and former supervisor of Ed Coyle), Doug Horne was told by Weiss that he now desires not to discuss his assassination recollections any further. ARRB staff is preparing a letter to Mr. Weiss encouraging him to meet with Gunn/Horne during their visit to Texas.8. On March 11, Wray, Barger and Masih met with Office of Naval Intelligence officials at ONI's Suitland headquarters. ONI POC LCDR Terri Pike intends to review identified ONI records not later than April 30 deadline given to subordinate commands by Department of the Navy. Extremely impressive presentation, knowledgeable people, and

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
