Subject: Weekly Report

I read the file of appealed FBI documents in preparation for writing the press release/media advisory. Material has been written and will start process of review this week. I am reading the Nagell USSS file and have a press release/media advisory partially written. That can go anytime after the file is shipped to NARA. I have read all the material snared by Eric from the Rankin papers and noted some for press use. I will go to NARA with Eric on Friday to review other material. I have notified members of the media who expressed interest in the April 2 hearing that the Review Board will meet April 24 at 11:30 a.m. here. There is some interest from AP, C-Span and Fox. Others haven't responded. Craig Brownstein of C-Span said they would consider it for coverage during a meeting Monday. I am to call him to determine what their plans may be. I talked with Mike Dorman, Newsday, regarding the April 24 meeting. Mr. Dorman said that the Review Board had received very little national attention in its brief history. He suggested that he write a magazine article, perhaps for The New Yorker, regarding the Review Board. He said he will approach the magazine editors with the idea. If they agree, Mr. Dorman will travel to Washington to conduct interviews and review the JFK Collection, etc. I arranged for Judge Tunheim to participate for a second time on Lonna Saunders WMAL talk show. I briefed Doug Horne on the pending press work needed on the NSA and Military Intercept documents. I talked with Mr. Lesar regarding a duplicate copy of the C-SPAN broadcast of the Review Board. I said that I would try to get him a duplicate. I have not yet done that. We did provide Mr. Lesar, as per his request, with a copy of the letter from Mr. Silverman regarding the Zapruder film. I responded to Mr. Jeff Morley's request for access to a data base of RIF numbers after discussing the situation with you. I have not heard again from Mr. Morley, but he may have called you concerning this matter. I engaged in a lengthy discussion with a Mr. John Tymon of Palm Springs, FL regarding his association with David Ferrie. Mr. Tymon wanted to speak to someone with authority and I referred him to Mr. Gunn. I talked with Bill Khorey, a member of the public, regarding a so-called Cliff Fenton Report on Oswald in New Orleans. Mr. Khorey could only reference the report as being mentioned on page 298-299 of Morrow's book, "First Hand Knowledge." He agreed, after his research, that there was very little to prove the report's existence. Mr. Brownstein of C-SPAN returned my call concerning a complimentary video copy of the April 2 Review Board hearing, saying that C-Span does not offer complimentary
