Subject: Conversation with Richard Hertling

After you and I spoke for the last time on Friday, I called Richard Hertling and advised him that the Specter bill was moving and would likely be introduced next week. He was pleased to hear that. In response to my inquiry, Hertling said that Senator Thompson would be advised when the bill was introduced. He said that the Review Board was not raised by Moynihan or anyone else at the hearing on the Moynihan Commission legislation. Hertling was aware that Moynihan was on McNeil/Lehrer, but offered no comment. There was no further discussion on the hearing. He did not offer much in the way of a response to me or commentary. So, I closed by saying that I had also advised Dettelbach of the day's developments and would keep him informed as we learned things.
