David: I put a call into Lardner today and left a message to acknowledge the article on the Rankin papers. It reminded me of a conversation I had with him early last week that was interesting. I told him that we had the bill on the President's desk for the extension. He said that was great, but he still thought that the Marines - - specifically ONI, would succeed in waiting us out, like "they've done before." Lardner clearly thinks ONI has documents that they don't want us to have. I didn't go into detail with him and I do not know the basis for his opinion. However, if we do get anything out of ONI, he would be interested. In light of the description in the annual report of the non-cooperation we have received from the Navy and the Marines, I thought his remarks were worth noting.
