Tom gave me a copy of your memo because I am working on identifying documents with a nexus to New Orleans and identifying those who should be considered as witnesses at the hearing relating to the documents. You mentioned Tom Bethell. Jim DiEugenio in his book "Destiny Betrayed" said Bethell was an Englishman and an expert on the assassination as well as one of Garrison's most important investigators. Bethell provided the prosecution's witness lists and testimony summaries to one of Clay Shaw's attorneys pre-trial. Throughout the investigation Bethell espoused his support of the Warren Commission report, which led DiEugenio to wonder why Bethell joined Garrison's staff in the first place. Also according to DiEugenio Bethell did publish a book about the Garrison case entitled "The Electric Windmill."
