Subject: Archives II research projects for staff or summer interns
Monday morning you asked me for suggestions for meaningful work at Archives II. At that time I suggested research on everything the WC and HSCA did to find Dealey Plaza witnesses/photos/films. When I am able to hire an investigator that person will work mostly if not completely on the Dealey Plaza photo issue and it will be a more efficient use of the investigator's time if the prior investigation's work is available. Since then I've received a fax from Gene Wheaton of Mr. Plumlee fame. He recommended the ARRB look for FBI files (also newspaper accounts) on I. Irving Davidson, allegedly the Washington "bagman-middleman" for the Pentagon-Intelligence community covert operators. Wheaton claims Davidson is an informant and friend of Jack Anderson's and a key in the CIA/Cuban/New Orleans connection. Wheaton also suggested the ARRB obtain files (FBI and DEA) on Nick Peter Popich, a former lieutenant of Carlos Marcello. Wheaton claims Popich fled the US in 1969 and is currently living in the UAE (Dubai) while remaining a fugitive in the US. If any of these searches yields results I would appreciate getting copies of whatever is found for my ongoing work with Wheaton. Thanks!
