"Davy also mentioned that in Michael Kurtz's article "Lee Harvey Oswald in New Orleans - A Re-appraisal" (published in 'Louisiana History' magazine) Kurtz mentioned a 98,000 page collection of FBI and CIA records about the assassination at Southeastern Louisiana State University in Hammond (where Kurtz teaches).
