was at the Archives today. Steve Tilley said that John Machado had told him that 5 boxes of material would be coming soon. He did not give a date or a description of what it will be. I suggested to Steve that he might not want to send the surviving boxes from accession 85-87-0004 (2-5) back to John Machado for RIFs. Instead, I thought it would be safer to photocopy all of the protective surveys and send copies to Machado so he can do the RIFs. I offered our services since Steve does not have the staff to do it. Steve thought this idea was reasonable. There are 2 boxes of material withheld by the Secret Service from the Warren Commission collection. One contains material about Marina Oswald that has been released in FBI records (although not in as much detail as in the Secret Service records). I only glanced at the other one, but I think it will crack the whole case wide open. Some of this material has RIFs. When you speak to Jane Vezeris, would you please make a point of asking her to tell you when Latita Roseboro will be going to Archives II to examine Secret Service material that is still being withheld? Latita is most familiar with Secret Service records that have already been released. If Latita will not go to Archives II to consider the releasability of the material, I will copy it and send request for evidence forms to Jane Vezeris. In his latest communication to us (last Friday), John Machado said that The Record (the internal newsletter of the Secret Service) was at NARA. (He offered this information in the context of being asked to check it for assassination related material, which he did not do.) I checked in the Textual Reference section at College Park with the help of Clarence Lyons. We discovered that the NARA collection dates from 1938 to 1959. Would you mind asking Jane Vezeris to ask John Machado to check The Record for 1963? The Textual Reference people gave me these three sheets from their Master Location Register (see attached).
