After shopping around for hi-tech mountain bikes for a new WhiteHouse patrol beat, the agency struck a deal: eight \$2,400 bicyclesfrom Trek for a deep-discounted \$300 apiece. ``As we were out looking around Trek actually offered them tous. But we wanted to pay something," said Carl Meyer, SecretService spokesman. The Trek bike has 24 gears, a main-frame shock absorber,drag-reducing wheel fans and a handlebar pack. It weighs only 24pounds. Inspector Dennis Martin was in charge of finding the bikes. Hesaid he first approached other branches of the federal governmentlast January to see if there were extra patrol bikes. But during aWhite House tour, Trek executive John Burke met Martin andencouraged him to look at their bikes at a discounted price.
