The number is reduced because several documents that were supposedly postponed or redacted were actually open in full (incl. SS#s) at NARA II.Also, you should know that of the 40+ documents reviewed at NARA II yesterday, there were discrepancies between the RIFs there and the RIFs attached to the same documents in the Leg. Vault in 13 cases (in the status and restrictions fields).
