As you may recall, Michelle came across a reference to SCI document(s) that had at one time been part of the HSCA Security Classified Files record series. Kris Wilhelm conveyed to us that Diane Dimkoff recalled the document(s) as having been withdrawn. Kris later found a 4/22/92 memo from Diane Dimkoff to Mike Gillette, indicating that the document(s) , formerly folder 157-JFK of the Security Classified Files series (and even more formerly 013214 of the Numbered Files), had been transferred to NND (NARA's declassification unit, currently housed with Steve Tilley's JFK Access operation) for storage. In her 4/22/92 memo, Dimkoff briefly describes the document(s) as a ... "discussion of intercepted communication. These documents are not intercepts." I gave Steve a copy of the '92 memo today and indicated that we would, of course, like to get our hands on this/these document(s). It was all news to him, but he said he'd run it down for us.
