Review Board's representative in the call: Joseph FreemanNARA's representative in the call: Steve TilleyDescription of the Call Date: 01/19/96Subject: Army Corps of Engineers records, re: JFK burial, discovered at Suitland.Summary of the Call:Steve called to inform us that NARA personnel at Suitland have come across 6 inches of Army Corps of Engineers records dealing with JFK's burial and gravesite (unclear if they include any material specific to the 1967 reinterment). These records are not yet accessioned; NARA is in touch with the Corps, who will have to do the data entry and recommend postponements (if any) under the JFK Act before any records show up at Steve's office. But we could go look at them immediately, if we thought it useful to do so. A Gerry Nasharon (sp?) in the Records Appraisal staff at NARA II is the point person. Steve wasn't sure, but suggested the materials contain site drawings but no photographs.Don't forget to compose individual Action Item documents for any action items that resulted from the call!
