Contrary to previous knowledge, the LEIU was never disbanded and has been functioning without interruption since 1956. The organization is an offshoot of the California State Department of Justice and is comprised of approximately 250 law enforcement agencies which share information through their headquarters in Sacramento, California. The LEIU specializes in compiling statistics re: organized crime figures. Rucker said his search included all headquarters files which should contain centralized information regarding all the LEIU's member agencies. As his letter indicated, this search did find any records dealing with our request. I thanked Rucker for providing this new information and he was glad to be of service to the Review Board.
