I have also attached a photocopy of a Feb. 64 Warren Commission memo written by Melvin Eisenberg, recounting a conversation with Chief Justice Warren, in which Warren told Eisenberg (and others on the staff) how Johnson raised the specter of nuclear war possibly occurring as a result of "rumors of the most exaggerated kind" leading to things getting out of hand---all this, in getting Warren to chair the Commission. I believe that this conversation---variants of which LBJ had with many others---may be related to some of the peculiarities at the autopsy, and this whole issue of the turban. In my fax, I explain why.
