Subject: Church Committee records at NARA II

FYI. Unless Steve and I are mistaken, we have encountered a major stumbling block to the effective utilization of those Church Committee records already processed and available at NARA II. The Church Committee RIFs reference box numbers from the original collection stored at NARA I (which run into the multiple hundreds), not the box numbers as they exist at NARA II (41 boxes). Since the records in the boxes at NARA II are not arranged in any particular RIF order (e.g., ascending numerical order), there is no way of locating -- from the information on the RIF -- where in the 41 boxes a given document might be. David, this is the problem we had in finding the other ML document you asked us to locate last week when I was out there -- if it hadn't been for the fact that the old folder-by-folder, NARA-generated finding aid, referenced ML in one instance, we wouldn't have found the one document we did find. Steve knows he's going to have to address this eventually, but his time frame is uncertain and in the meantime the main value of having the Church Committee disks on our database will be to identify (as opposed to locate) that a given record is, in fact, part of the JFK Collection.
