President who succeeded Kennedy John Edgar Hoover Director, Federal Bureau of Investigation Jim Garrison New Orleans District Attorney who alleged a conspiracy to kill President Kennedy Clay Shaw New Orleans businessman who was tried by Jim Garrison with conspiracy to kill President Kennedy Guy Bannister Reactionary political activist in New Orleans who associated with Lee Harvey Oswald in summer of 1963 David W. Ferrie Reactionary political activist in New Orleans who associated with Clay Shaw, Guy Bannister and Lee Harvey Oswald in summer of 1963 Edward G. Lansdale U. S. Air Force General involved in covert operations during 1950s and 1960s Lucien E. Conien U. S. Army General involved in covert operations; reportedly associated with French Corsican Mafia during and after W.W. II; reportedly involved in U. S.-backed coup against President Diem of Vietnam in 1963; and alleged to have been present in Dallas, Texas on the day President Kennedy was assassinated Charles A. Willoughby (aka Right-wing retired U. S. Army General involved in reactionary Adolf Tscheppe-Weidenbach) politics in late 1950s and early 1960s Curtis E. LeMay U. S. Air Force Chief of Staff in 1963 Pierre A. Finck U. S. Army pathologist who participated in autopsy on President Kennedy; dual U.S.-Swiss citizen who has resided in both Belgium and Switzerland Richard Case Nagell Former U. S. Army CIC officer who was reportedly arrested in GDR on June 10, 1968 and released to U. S. authorities on October 23, 1968; this individual (now deceased) claimed to have had foreknowledge of impending Kennedy assassination Franz Waehauf Bartender at Hotel Luma in Mexico City in 1962-63 who observed and spoke with Lee Harvey Oswald; reportedly Czech intelligence, and working with Cuban intelligence Robert Clayton Buick American bullfighter in Mexico City who observed Richard Case Nagell and Lee Oswald in Hotel Luma in Mexico City in 1963 Warren Broglie Manager of Hotel Luma in Mexico City Winston Scott CIA Station Chief for Mexico City in 1963 David A. Phillips CIA covert operations officer James J. Angleton CIA Head of Counterintelligence Jean Rene Souetre Former French OAS Captain and reputed assassin; according to CIA 1964 memo quoting French government, expelled from U. S. 48 hours after
