In that capacity, he would have monitored the activities of the 112th INTC Group and read their reports. He is also the likely author of the message sent from 4th Army to Strike Command on the evening of November 22, 1963, describing the background of "Harvey Lee Oswald" based on information apparently gleaned from 112th INTC records.
