She said that all the material referenced in the index now in the ARRB's possession is unclassified and open to the public. She said that they do have a record that "3 cubic feet" of material is stored in Washington DC, and is currently held by the Departments of State, Defense, and the CIA. She said that the Lansdale papers were originally donated to the Hoover Institution in the mid-1980's, and small amounts have been trickling back to Palo Alto in the years since, most recently in 1990. She has agreed to fax us a copy of the most recent letter from the Department of Defense regarding these releases, so that we will know either the people to contact or at the very least, the offices in which new contacts might be located. It would appear that the next step for Board staff to take might be to contact the DoD offices indicated by the fax, and to request of State and CIA (Nina and Barry?) that they perform a search for the records that the Hoover Institution says they still have of General Lansdale's. Whatever classified material may remain should be reviewed by Board staff to determine whether or not
