Military/medical team highlights for past week:1. Visit by Wray/Barger/Montague to National Personnel Records Center in St. Louis yielded substantial information regarding various individuals. Probably the most significant find was location of personnel file on Edward J. Coyle, a former special agent in the 112th INTC Group's Dallas office whose activities on November 22, 1963 have been the subject of intense speculation among researchers. Aside from general background data, information gained during the visit should allow us to locate surviving individuals and contact them regarding their personal recollections.2. Stringer deposition.3. After many calls and letters, Floyd Riebe (Stringer's assistant during autopsy) called ARRB offices. Riebe affirmed statements previously attributed to him by various researchers regarding his role in taking photos at autopsy, and consented to repeating his statements under oath at some future point.4. The Army currently has a management intern doing RIF's on ~300 documents, photos, etc. belonging to the Army Corps of Engineers relating to preparation of permanent gravesite at Arlington and reinterment of JFK. Upon completion of this, the intern (Laura Bell) will begin working at ARRB offices to do RIF's on other Army
