Subject: Reich Callback

Colonel Reich called me back this AM to advise that he will not immediately be able to send us a copy of the letter he wrote to Army G2 denying the account told by Prouty and others. After looking for it last night, he realized it was with other personal papers that he placed in a footlocker and sent to his son. His son is a university professor in Ft. Collins, CO, and currently on a summer research trip in Europe for the next two weeks. I told Reich that we will prepare a transcript of our conversation and mail it to him for his review, and that following that I would probably would come down to Orlando to interview him in person and go over the transcript, various unit documents we've found, and (hopefully) receive from him the letter currently in his son's possession. Reich is very cooperative and, I think, now energized about helping us and especially identifying particular individuals from unit rosters that might have had duties of interest to us (e.g. the guy who kept dossier file on Oswald, etc.).
