with research leads for ARRB to pursue (people who might know something about the U-2 disinformation  
program):Lockheed:(1) Bob Murphy (a retired U-2 engineer): (805) 947-6285(2) Frank Dewar (Bob Murphy's  
Deputy)...not sure, but may be at Lockheed's Ontario office...(714) 395-2121CIA:(1) John Parangosky (was  
Bissell's direct assistant for U-2 program matters, and was involved in other black projects, such as the SR-71  
Blackbird; Janos says that after Bissell was "canned," Parangosky took over the U-2 program); Janos said he  
lives somewhere in Maryland. Janos feels we are more likely to get valuable information on this story from  
Parangosky than anyone else.(2) Don Welzenbach, a CIA historian...location unknown.(3) Jim Barnes, who  
Janos described as "Senior U-2 Pilot" for the CIA for many years, from the mid-1950s through about 1990.  
Janos feels Barnes would be very likely to know something useful about this story. (415) 694-6465USAF: (1)  
Retired General Leo Gary, USAF, was reportedly very close to Kelley Johnson, Lockheed's famous U-2 designer.  
Janos believes he may be a good source--he said that although co-author Ben Rich and he did not get much  
information from General Gary, he feels he might provide more information to a government agency like the  
ARRB: (303) 771-8720(2) Retired Air Force Colonel Barry Hennessey (who Janos thinks is somewhere in  
McLean, Virginia), was associated with CIA black programs, according to Janos.(3) Pete Eames was another  
USAF officer's name given me by Janos; he thought that Eames may have some professional connection with  
Barry Hennessey (above).(4) Air Force Historian Richard Hallion at Andrews AFB (202) 767-5764 x233; Janos  
thinks Hallion may know something about the U-2 disinformation program, or have records, simply because of  
his position as Air Force historian.
