Date: 08/19/96Subject: Destruction of IRR RecordSummary of the Call:Bob Watson of IRR called Tim Wray to
report the inadvertent destruction (apparently in September 1995) of the original copy of some investigative
records flagged for JFK interest. On list provided to ARRB of records related to JFK assassination, this record is
"26J" dealing with individuals named "Lubnin" (first name not given) and Joseph Dutkanicz. IRR still has a
complete photocopy of this file, so no records have been permanently lost. Watson asked Wray what actions
he should take to document the destruction. Wray recommended Watson prepare a "memorandum for
record" explaining the date, time and circumstances under which original records were destroyed as
thoroughly as possible; a copy of this MFR should then be filed with the photocopy file.Wray also told Watson
that Brian Rosen will probably be visiting IRR at some point in the near future to seek files on another matter
possibly related to JFK assassination (alleged gunrunning scheme involving military weapons stolen from Ft.
Hood, Texas).
