He noted that his coauthor, Gerald Haines, may have retained copies of the FOIA-processed workpapers. Also this afternoon, after a few attempts that got no answer at all, I was able to leave a voicemail message for Haines, so there is still hope that we will be able to get primary source material, declassified by the FBI, from him.
