This afternoon I spoke with David Langbart, who told me that he did not keep for himself copies of the FOIA-processed FBI/NARA Task Force workpapers, and that NARA would not have retained such copies for papers that were scheduled for destruction. He said that he would try to locate a copy of the disposition schedule of the Task Force's papers to send to us. He noted that his coauthor, Gerald Haines, may have retained copies of the FOIA-processed workpapers. Also this afternoon, after a few attempts that got no answer at all, I was able to leave a voicemail message for Haines, so there is still hope that we will be able to get primary source material, declassified by the FBI, from him. In the meantime, I have drafted a letter to Bill Leary relying on what is published in Unlocking the Files(which, it seems to me, is more than sufficient to make our point).
