Chris did a great job yesterday of digging through the SF 135's on records from ONI and DIA deposited at Suitland. The ONI 135's appear to have some promising leads -- nothing spectacular, but hopefully stuff that will get our foot in the door with respect to understanding the assassination-contemporaneous actions of that agency. The DIA 135's are harder to decipher: according to Chris, they contain mostly "number entries" as opposed to narrative descriptions, so we need to find another way to crack those before we can start to mine them. For both ONI and DIA, at least we know where their records are now. After further consulting with Chris and the agencies themselves, I will try to come up with a suitable program (ideally using agency personnel rather than ARRB staff) for digging through the Suitland records.
