**Subject:** Oswald DD 1173 Action Items

I gave this subject a bit more thought and wish to correct my earlier, simplistic response by recommending we pursue these four courses of action:(1) Interview former 1st LT A. G. Ayers, Jr., USMC (the officer in charge of Oswald's separation paperwork) by telephone (draft contact letter is in your in-box); (page 14 of memo)(2) Attempt to locate (via Dave Montague) L. B. Wallace, former Clerk of the Superior Court at Santa Ana, California so that a telephone interview can be conducted regarding questions about Oswald's passport application & I.D. card; (page 14 of memo)(3) Contact State Department to obtain contemporaneous guidance (circa 1959) re: issuance of passports to active duty members of the armed forces (i.e., what were the prohibitions then, if any?); (page 14 of memo)(4) Contact Dennis Vetock at the Army War College at Carlisle, Pennsylvania (you already obtained his phone number for me) to obtain the contemporaneous guidance re: issuance of the DD 1173 I. D. card--we need both initial guidance from July '57-July'59, and the changes reportedly issued effective July '59; I will be glad to call him if you give me the thumbs up. (page 5 of memo)
