Frank Ellsworth was an agent for the Internal Revenue Service, division of Alcohol and Tobacco Tax (now ATF) in Dallas in the fall of 1963. He was investigating Mason, George C. Nonte Jr. and gunrunning out of Fort Hood around the time of the assassination, and he is alleged to have met with James Hosty and Ed Coyle on the day of the assassination. Mason was a gun dealer in Dallas in 1963 with right-wing and anti-Castro Cuban connections. He was one of two Dallas gun dealers that sold the type of ammunition used in the assassination. He was alleged to be involved in gunrunning with Nonte and was arrested on minor gun charges on November 20 (two days before the assassination he posted bail and was released the next day.)
