The reason they have this document is because the widow of General Blumberg, who had received this report from Finck, donated her husband's papers to the Museum after his death. I told him that Tim Wray and I would be calling on him sometime in the next month to examine the original Blumberg Report, and to see whether he has anything else of interest in the Museum.He gave me 2 leads to pursue at AFIP in our search for internal memoranda, reports, notes etc. from the autopsy:-Ms. Bonnie Short, the AFIP Records Manager (go through Otis switchboard at 782-2100)--he thinks any such records would have been deposited at the Federal Records Center at Suitland, and that Ms. Short may be able to tell us where to look out there;- Ms. Annette Anderson, head of the Records Repository Division at AFIP (at 782-1630)--she deals with pathology records.END
