1. OSD (Ofc of Sec Defense) and Joint Staff both notified us that they have assembled what they consider to be assassination-related materials and are processing those to hand over to us. I have been allowed to look through these, and nearly all deal with Cuba in the 62-63 timeframe. These documents should be a good complement to the Califano Cuba documents at NARA. 2. Tim/Brian visited Army CID (Criminal Investigation Division) records managers at Ft. Belvoir on Sept 6. CID act as "detectives" above uniformed Military Police. According to cryptic HSCA references, CID investigative records were shown to HSCA investigators regarding gunrunning activities possibly connecting the theft of weapons from Ft. Hood and right-wing groups in Dallas. (Army intelligence agent Ed Coyle met the morning of 22 Nov 63 with FBI SA Hosty and ATF agent Ellsworth to discuss this case.) CID records managers promised full cooperation, and will begin a search of records for relevant files ASAP. Brian is preparing an official letter to them stating our requirements and listing additional names/cases for them to pursue.3. Scheduled interview with former Col (USAF) L.
