CALL REPORT: PUBLICHere is the information on Colonel Paul Miller, U. S. A., retired. At the time of JFK's death Miller was head of ceremonies for the Commanding General of MDW, General Philip C. Wehle. During Joe Hagan's interview with ARRB about Gawler's involvement with JFK's burial preparations, he showed us a funeral planning document (a hand-bound book about one inch thick) which had been loaned to him by Paul Miller. Apparently, Paul Miller was directly responsible for all of the detailed funeral arrangements, and this book is the written record of all the planning that went into President Kennedy's funeral. Tim Wray and Jeremy Gunn have both expressed an interest in obtaining a good copy of that document (or the original, if Colonel Miller would wish to donate it to the Archives via ARRB). He agreed to arrive at our offices about 9:45 A. M. on Friday, May 17, 1996 in response to our subpoena. He recommended that we may wish to interview Colonel Paul Miller (Retired), who was Chief of Ceremonies and Special Events for MDW at the time of the Kennedy Assassination. He said he had just recently had lunch with Colonel Miller, which is why he was recommending this to us; he provided Col. Miller's phone number: (703) 780-2340. He said that it was Colonel Miller who tasked Gawler's to perform the services on President Kennedy, and it was Colonel Miller who was responsible for all state funeral arrangements for President Kennedy's funeral. He seemed to be looking forward to his interview by ARRB, and promised to bring all relevant records with him as directed by the subpoena.
